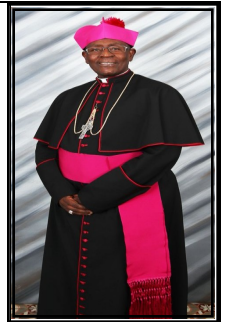

INTRODUCTION TO THE LITURGY OF THE WORD

FIRST READING: Isalah 53:10-11

If the servant of the Lord "gives His life as an offering for sin, He shall see His descendants in a long life."

SECOND READING: Hebrews 4:14-16

Brothers and sisters: "Let us confidently approach the throne of grace."

GOSPEL READING: Mark 10:35-45 or 10:42-45

Jesus replied to James and John, "The Son of Man did not come to be served but to serve and to give His life as a ransom for many."

The theme running through today's readings is service and our Lord's commitment to be the servant of all. Isaiah prophesies about a servant who will suffer and give His life as an offering for sin. The reading from Hebrews reminds us that Jesus was tested in every way, willing to become weak for our sake. In the Gospel, Jesus tells His disciples he came not to be served but to serve. Let today's readings inspire us to serve others as we live out our faith.

Saint John Paul II, Pope

Saint John Paul II was born on May 18, 1920 in Wadowice, Poland. On October 16, 1978 while serving as Cardinal Karol Wojtyla, Archbishop of Krakow, he was elected the 263rd successor to Saint Peter and chose the name John Paul II in honor of the late John Paul I. Pope John Paul II was the first ever Slavic Pope elected, and at 58-years-old, he was youngest Pope in over a century. During his twenty-six-year pontificate, he visited over 129 countries, which included seven visits to the United States. He died on April 2, 2005, beatified in St. Peter's Square on May 1, 2011, by Pope Benedict XVI, and canonized on April 27, 2014, by Pope Francis. His feast day is October 22. Pope John Paul II died in the Apostolic Palace at 9:37 p.m. on Saturday, 2 April 2005, the vigil of Sunday *in albis* or Divine Mercy Sunday, which he had instituted. On 8 April, his solemn funeral was celebrated in Saint Peter's Square and he was buried in the crypt of Saint Peter's Basilica.
